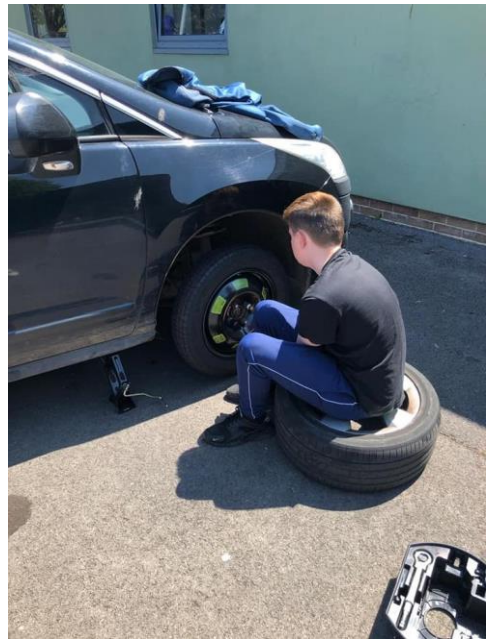

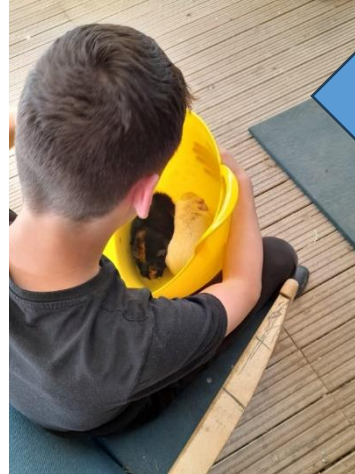

Offsite visit to Rodway Farm at Cannington College to learn about careers in Agriculture



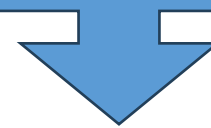

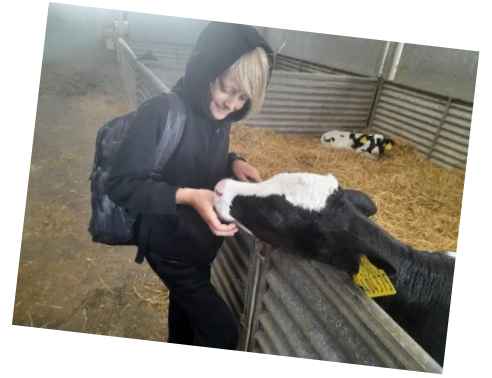


The Base became a Barber shop with our brave Outdoor Education Lead in the role of the client!

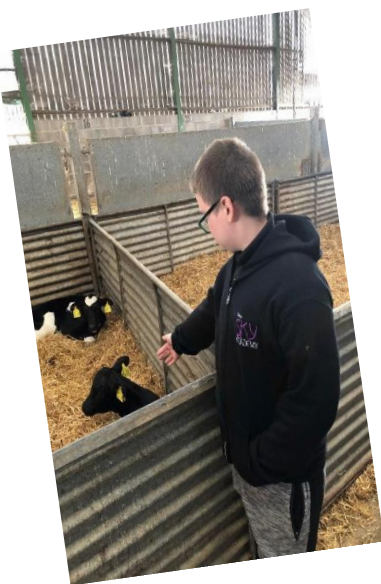


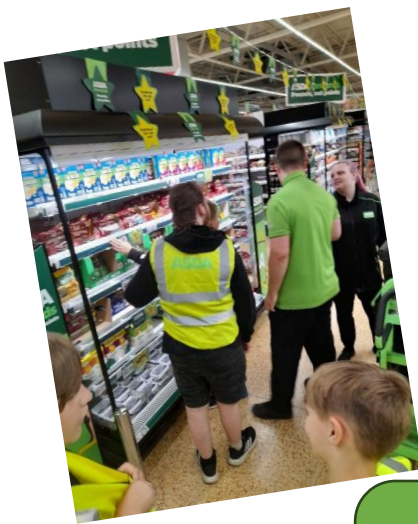
Sky welcomed the Army onsite to run some of their team building training exercises. Brilliant participation all round!
